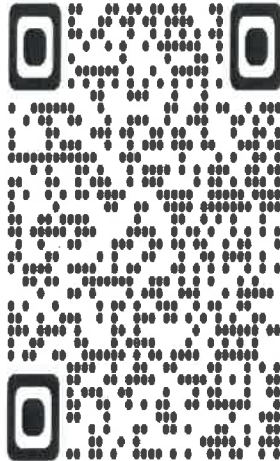

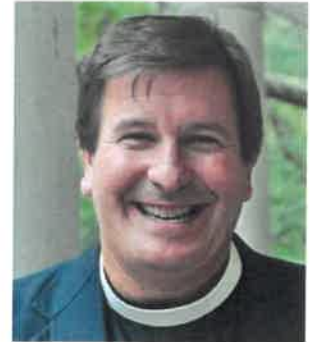

Dear Children of God,

What does the Resurrection mean for us today?

Begin to pay attention to the Resurrection/Redemption He wants to bring into my situation; healing, wholeness, recovery, Resurrection.

Grow in my Friendship, Spiritual Relationship with Jesus. Some people are very anti-religious, they have been hurt by religious leaders. But the Gospel is not about religion. The Gospel is about a Friendship with Jesus.

John 15:13-14 - *13 Greater love hath no man than this, that he lay down his life for his **friends**. 14 You are **my friends** if you do what I command you.*

As we receive and believe the Apostolic witness of the bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ, we can begin and grow in our friendship with Jesus. Amen?

On Saturday, March 30th the Trinity Flower Guild and friends gathered to decorate the Trinity for Easter. The results were absolutely beautiful.

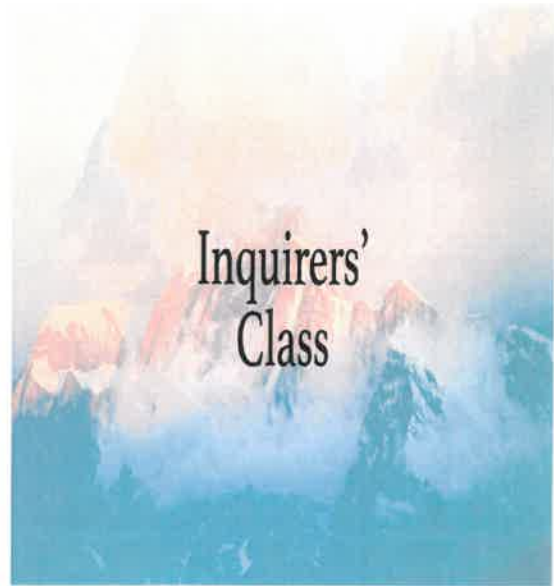

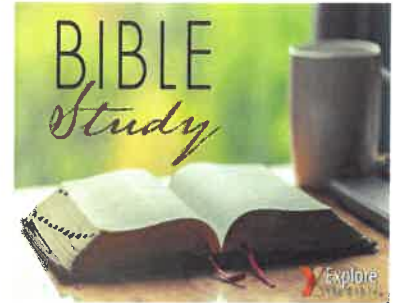

Community Bible Study

What our attention is on is going to affect what we believe. It will either strengthen our faith or weaken it. The Monday No Homework Bible study class is focused on building great faith that will triumph in a crisis.

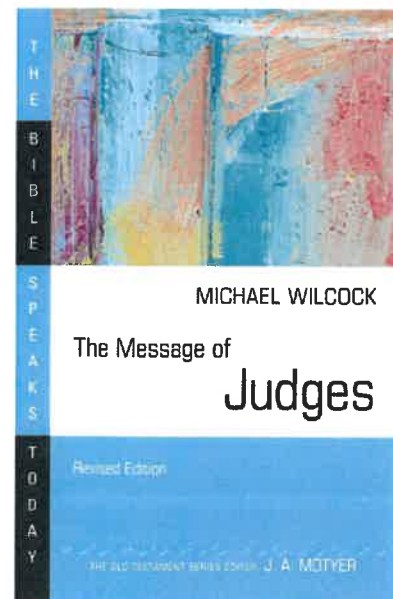

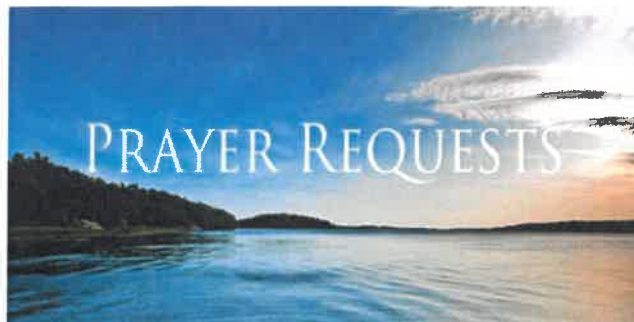

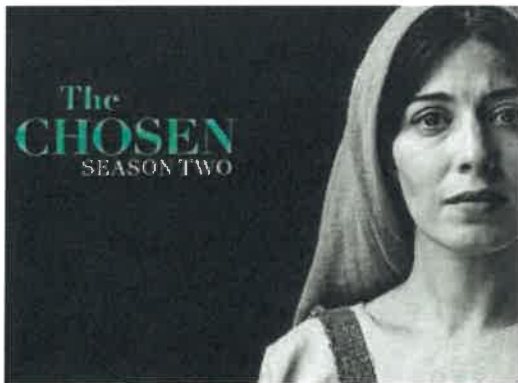
