



Lenten Blessings

The parish I attended as a child held a yearly Lenten Program known as "Lenten Learning". One of my favorite memories was the year the organist took request for favorite hymns as part of the opening service. I was thrilled when my suggestion was among those selected.

I was cognizant of the privilege that was afforded to someone my age. But I remember being especially proud when several parishioners-adults no less -complimented me on my recommendation. The one I most remember came from Miss Ann Hirst, sister-in-law of our Rector and head of the Sunday School. Although a formidable presence, she was not unkind and a compliment from Miss Hirst felt like receiving a gold star.

Many decades later when I first started supplying at Trinity I began the practice of visiting the grave of my childhood Rector and the man most responsible for my entering the priesthood, The Revd William Lumpkin. Among those buried beside him in the family plot are his wife, and sister-in law, Miss Hirst. Imagine my shock upon discovering that her marker bears the words "Breathe on Me Breath of God," the opening line of the hymn that I had recommended.


Every time I visit the grave and offer prayers of thanksgiving for their influence on my life, I cannot help but smile at the memory of the night when I first felt like a real member of my church.

This Lent whether you seek to honor God through giving up something, taking something on, or a combination of both; I pray that your choice will never cease being a blessing to you.

After over sixty years I am still receiving my Lenten Blessing in ways that I could never have imagined.


Know One Another - Small GroupsMARCH WITH THE DAUGHTERS OF THE KING





God is calling you to a passionate love relationship with Himself. Because the answer to religious complacency isn't working harder at a list of do's and don'ts—it's falling in love with




Good Samaritan Clinic Easter Open House!
