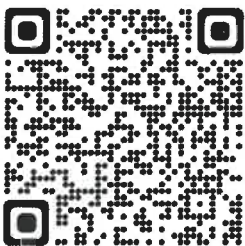

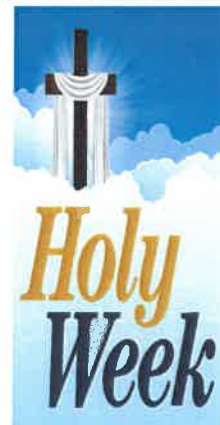

Dear Children of God,

I Corinthians 15:29 - *If in Christ we have hope in this life only, we are of all people most to be pitied.*

The Apostle Paul speaks about Christians, Christ followers, who do not have a hope for heaven. They follow Christ for this life only. And the Apostle Paul calls them - pitiful!

But Jesus Christ was Resurrected on the third day! Never to die again! The Easter Celebration! And for Believers who are in Christ - His Resurrection becomes our future Resurrection! The way Randy Alcorn wrote about it in Heaven is:

“What God made us to desire, and therefore what we do desire if we admit it, is exactly what he promises to those who follow Jesus Christ: a resurrected life in a resurrected body, with the resurrected Christ on a resurrected Earth.” (Heaven, Randy Alcorn, p.7)

Randy Alcorn goes on to review the biblical texts dividing them into two areas. Either they are referring to the Present Heaven, an immediate presence with Jesus when Believers physically pass away or the New Earth, the Resurrected Life at the Second Coming of Christ.

Therefore Believers never die, we never cease to exist. Our existence in the Life of Christ continues on. We pass away from this life into the Present Heaven, the very presence of Jesus.

My mother, Helen Oeland Coker, passed away this past Tuesday, March 21st, but she did not die. Jesus was and is always with her. She continues to exist in His Present Heaven!

Yes, I am sad in my loss of her in this life, but I am so glad I will be reunited with her and our Savior Jesus Christ in His Present Heaven and in the future, the New Resurrected Earth!

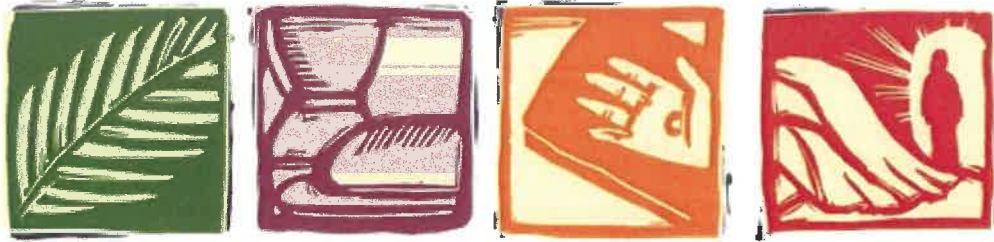

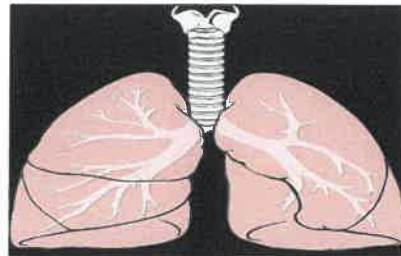

Last month we mentioned the "10 Key Health Benefits of Participating in a Choir", for example, the Trinity Choir! I would like to break down the first of those benefits in today's article.

### 1) Improves lung function

- chronic obstructive pulmonary disorder (COPD)
- asthma
- cystic fibrosis
- cancer
- multiple sclerosis
- quadriplegia



While singing doesn't treat or cure any of these conditions, you may benefit from gaining strength in your respiratory muscles. Singing also increases the amount of oxygen in your blood, research shows. In addition to the pulmonary benefits, singers also experience improved mood and a greater sense of social connection.

There is no better time of year to start your health focused decision to reap the rewards from joining a choir ! Easter is a time of celebration ! "He is Risen" so :

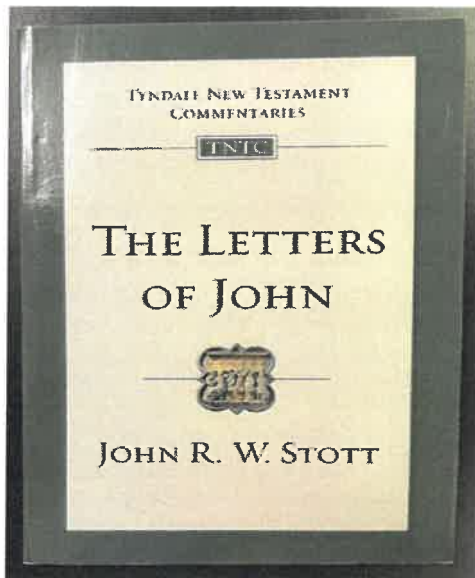

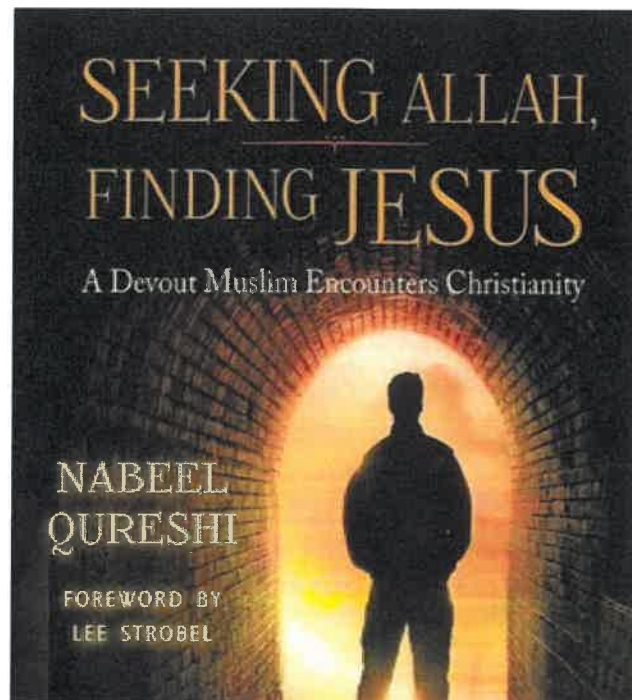
### **Men's Bible Study**

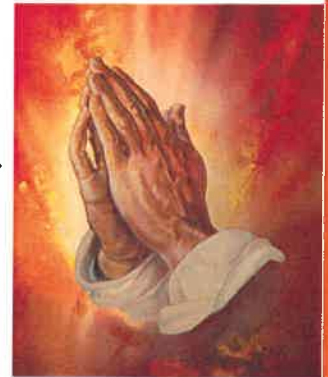

### **April with the Daughters**

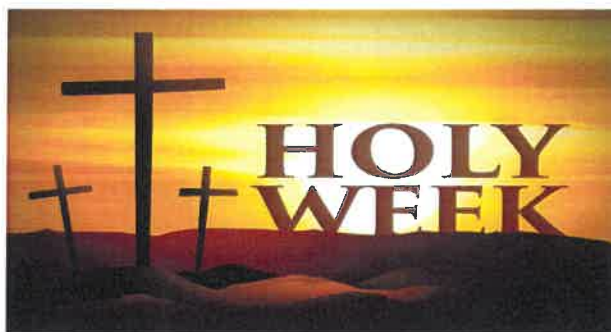

Bridgett Kolplen took them on a tour of the LOR building and explained the job of this organization.

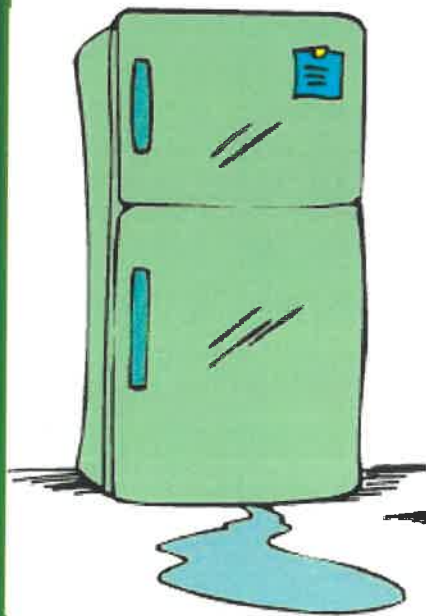
They were very appreciative of these gifts. They are a comfort to the children that are unable to bring any personal items from their homes. They are a source of security that they need at this rough time in their lives.

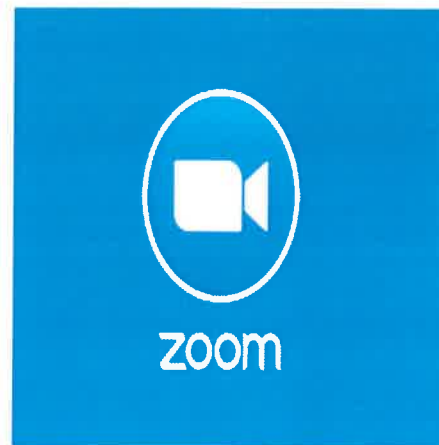
## ***Good Samaritan Clinic Easter Open House!***

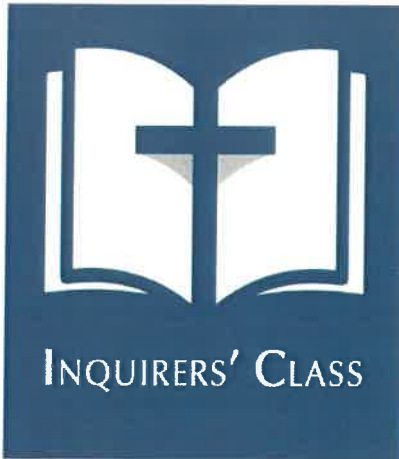

## News from the Graveyard

The long anticipated new “Policies and Guidelines for use of Trinity Church Graveyard” are finally here. You can get your free copy from the church lobby or contact the church office and they will be happy to email you a copy([office@trinityedisto.com](mailto:office@trinityedisto.com)). Now tell me that doesn't sound exciting! Don't everyone holler at once. If you can't wait to get your copy, here is a synopsis of the major changes:

1. There are no more 4x10 plots available. If any are returned in the future we will make them available for sale. Until then only spaces on the Memorial Wall are available.
2. The major change is the price which hasn't changed in ten years. The current price until June first will be honored at \$500.00 for one space on the Memorial Wall. Two persons ashes may be interred for such fee and two names may be inscribed on the Memorial plaque. The price will go up to \$1000.00 June first. If you wish to take care of this so your descendants won't have to after you are gone, best get a spot now before the price change. Just get an application from the church office and contact a Graveyard committee member to make an appointment to choose a location at the Wall. You will receive a confirmation for your records. Then you will be done with it and not have to think of it again. Box checked!!
3. We also eliminated the “friends” price category. The lineal descendant category is still there. If this is a matter of concern for you please speak with a vestry member.
4. The rest of the changes just better define our procedures.



In the mean time we are still washing the tombstones and planning improvements at the Memorial Wall. We have heard your concerns about making sure we show honor and respect for those interred there.

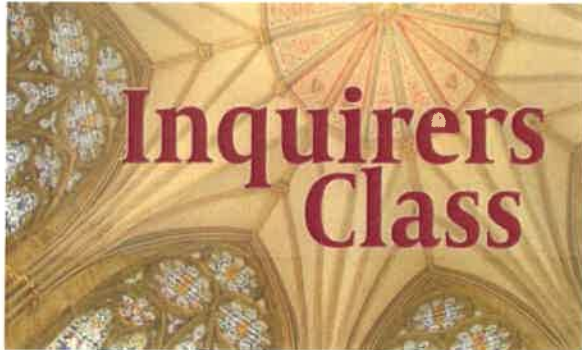
