

Dear Children of God,

For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven: (Ecclesiastes 3:1)

I remember first learning about "seasons" working as a CPA in Atlanta, Georgia, and the season was Tax Season! In FROM OUR RECTOR the CPA firm we worked long hours - came in early, stayed late, did not take lunch breaks. It was exhausting, but everyone in the office did it! But after Tax Day, April 15th, we started coming to work on time, left work on time, took longer lunch breaks and even had an office party!

COVID-19 seems to be a season. We changed our life patterns: social distancing, staying home, washing hands, sanitizing, face masks. But now the season seems to be winding down, and the rhythms of life seem to be returning. Or are they?

When tax season was over, I had to be encouraged by some senior staff to shift back into our normal work flow - stop working overtime, start taking a lunch break with other staff, regain the regular rhythm of office life.

So it seems to be with COVID-19. We need to be encouraged to regain our regular rhythms of life, including our life as Believers - weekly worship, fellowship breakfast, bible study, prayer groups, choir practice, mission ministries - those activities with other Believers that helped us grow in His grace.

Our Vestry is observing the decline of COVID-19 cases and considering shifting our Sunday worship back into the historic sanctuary which would also enable us to re-start our Sunday Fellowship Breakfast. But all of this will take leadership and participation. The Fellowship Breakfast itself takes four (4) teams coming together once a month. Plus a fifth Sunday team! (See announcement in this Trumpet)

Please receive this as my encouragement to consider the rhythms of life that help you grow in His grace, and return to them.

"No Homework" Bible Study







The Quilts of Valor Foundation is a group of people around the United States that make quilts for our veterans. They present these quilts at a special ceremony that honor the sacrifices these indiviuals have made for our country to preserve the freedoms we all enjoy.

The headquarters is a remarkable place! The workers cut material, piece quilts, put together kits, back the quilts, quilt the blankets, and then bind them. It was amazing!

LOWCOUNTRY ORPHAN RELIEF

The Lowcountry Orphan Relief is a foundation that helps children move from their homes to a family that will be able to take care of their needs. Each child is given a duffle bag with 2 weeks of clothing, tolietries, and school supplies.



Other Opportunities

Cleanest Indoor Air on Edisto!

Indoor gatherings at Trinity Church are now safer than ever. We have received shipment and are using our four new "clean air curtain" Air Cleaners. All four are deployed in the Meech Room for our Sunday services. They are portable and can be moved to other rooms for smaller meetings as needed.

These units provide real time purification of the room air, "the air that we share," during these meetings. Each unit has TWO filters, a pre-filter and a HEPA filter, AND a sealed ultra violet chamber that capture or kill 99.9% of all airborne droplets and particulate matter, providing the cleanest air possible.



The pandemic has taught us that transmission of COVID as well as all other flu and bacterial respiratory diseases is primarily from person to person exposure of droplets that are aerosolized as we sneeze, cough, sing or simply talk. Having these devices in place to clean the air that we share when we meet is a huge step forward for Trinity as we move to return to more normal indoor gatherings.

The Rev. Jim Lewis, Canon to the Ordinary, in the Diocesan Office, commended Trinity on being the first church in the Diocese to provide this additional layer of protection for our parishioners.
