The Feast of the Epiphany *The Burning of the Greens and Oyster Roast!*

The Feast of the Epiphany is always **January 6th**, the day after the 12th Day of Christmas and this year it falls on Thursday. Our Burning of the Greens and Oyster Roast (5:30 - 7:30 p.m.) includes candles and a huge bon fire which symbolizes the light of Christ going out into the world. Please bring your old Christmas trees and wreaths to the burn pile by the back parking lot before the 6th!

The Oyster Roast begins a 5:30 p.m. and hot dogs and chili will be available for our non-Oyster eaters. A short service and bon fire will occur around 6:30 p.m. and then we conclude with a few more oysters (if there are any left!) and cutting the King's Cake. The child, or adult, who finds the baby Jesus in their piece of the King's Cake is blessed for the new year!

"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen"

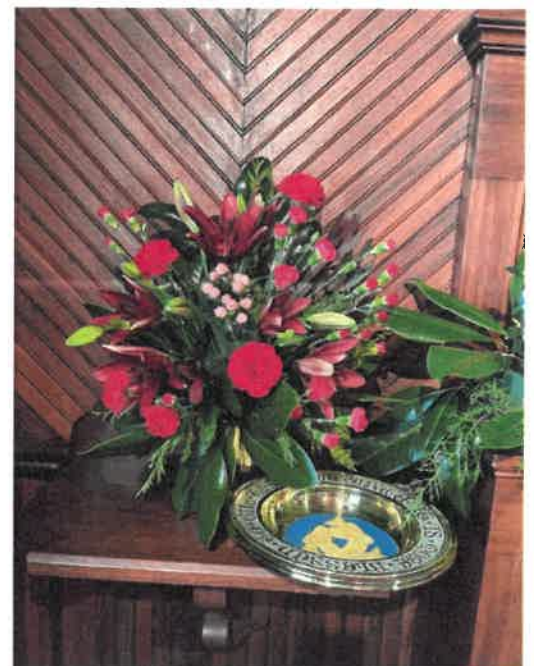
Rather than write an article for the Trumpet about the Flower Guild's Christmas decor that has yet to take place, we point to Hebrews 11.

Cursillo means “A Short Course in Christianity.”

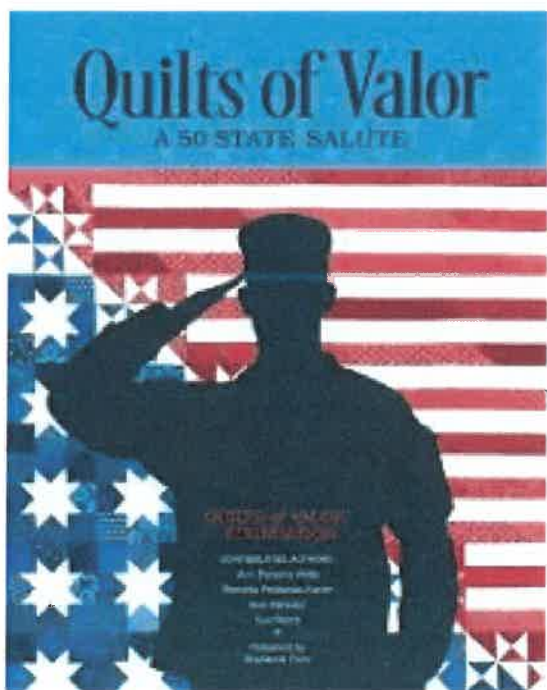
Sponsored by the Anglican Diocese of South Carolina, the Cursillo Weekend takes place at Camp St. Christopher two times a year.

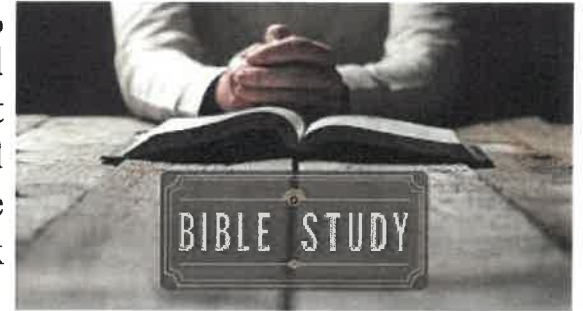

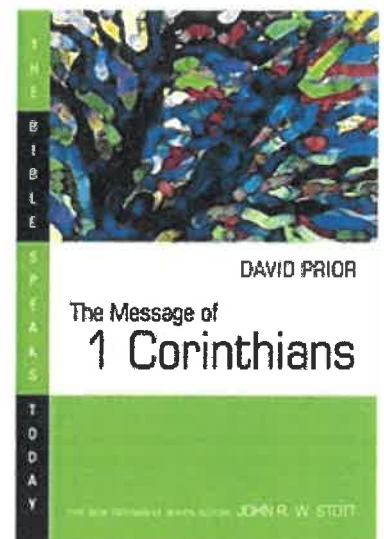
The Men’s Bible Study

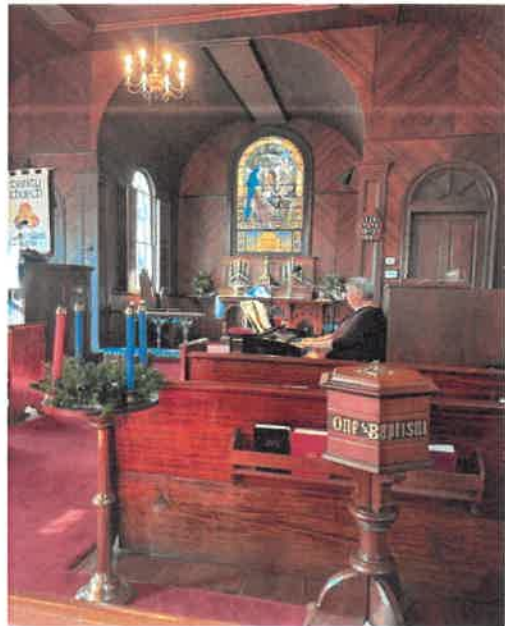
