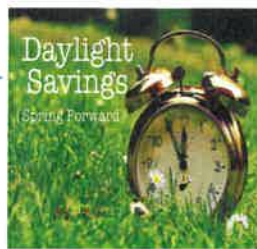

Dear Children of God,

"I invite you, therefore, in the name of the Church, to the observance of a holy Lent: by self-examination and repentance; by prayer, fasting and alms-giving; and by reading and meditating on God's holy Word."
(2019 BCP, p.544)



What are you going to give up for Lent? What are you going to take on for Lent? Lent is an opportunity to try Spiritual Disciplines. **Spiritual Disciplines are physical activities we do to open our spiritual hearts to receive more grace from Jesus.**

In Matthew 6 Jesus calls us to three Spiritual Disciplines in His Sermon on the Mount - Almsgiving, Prayer and Fasting.

Almsgiving - 6:3 *But when you give to the needy, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, 4 so that your giving may be in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you.* Make an anonymous donation to the Edisto Good Samaritan Clinic, Edisto Food Pantry or the Edisto Home Mission Team? I can give you the mailing address.

Prayer - 6:6 *But when you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you.* Engage fully in our Lenten Secret Prayer Partner ministry. Find out some of the needs of your prayer partner to lift up - in secret!

Fasting - 6:17 *But when you fast, anoint your head and wash your face, 18 that your fasting may not be seen by men but by your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you.* Try a new type of fast each week - sugar, refined flour, potatoes, white rice. Skip breakfast. Skip dinner. 12 hour, 24 hour, 36 hour, 72 hour fast?

The season of Lent is 40 days, excluding Sundays which are always Resurrection (feast) Days. Remember we live under Grace, not under Law (Romans 6:14)

What is Cursillo?

- “Cursillo” is Spanish for “a short course.” It is a movement of the church. Its purpose is to help those in the church understand their individual callings to be Christian Leaders.
- Cursillo is not designed to meet every spiritual need of every individual or group in the church. It is designed for the participant to “get away” from the daily routine, to listen to the Spirit and live for three days in Christian Community so that through study, worship, fellowship and introspection, one might sense the deeper calling of Christ in their lives to further service in His Church and know how to move forward on this journey.
- The overall goal of Cursillo is the goal of the Church: to bring all to Christ. This is done when informed, trained Christians set out with the support of others having a similar commitment. The Cursillo Weekend takes people who are already Christians and gives them foundational training based on the New Testament Christianity and helps them further discover their own “apostolic calling” based on their individual spiritual gifts!
- But most of all the Cursillo Weekend is about experiencing the unconditional Love of Jesus and Christian brothers and sisters in a way that you probably never have before. It is a taste of “Heaven on earth” and it is very often a life-changing event for participants!

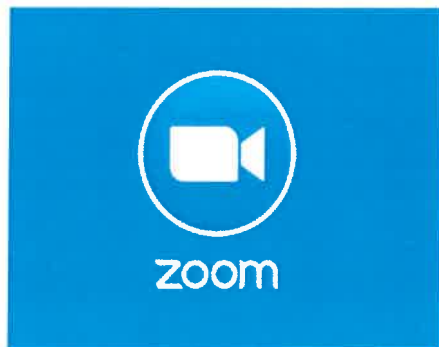
Toiletries Needed
