## Dear Children of God,

Donald Sterling, the owner of the LA Clippers, made so recently that became public and caused a lot of negative publicity. The Clippers are a team of the National Basketball Association included the Commissioner of the NBA banning Mr. Sterling from the life and a fine of \$2.5 million dollars.

This became a clear example of the coercive power of law embraced by a society. There was agreement over what was wrong and there was that Law. Mr. Sterling broke the Moral Law and, in this case, there were immediate consequences. We'll see how the rest of the story unfolds.

But how does a Christian respond to the issue of racism? Do we speak it is against God's Law? Do we speak against it because society, at this point willing to enforce this portion of God's Law? How would a Christian speak.

It's interesting because in Antioch St. Paul confronted St. Peter about his Paul never referred to God's Law, such as "Love your neighbor as yourself."

St. Paul wrote *But when I saw their conduct was not in step with the truth* (Gal.2:14) St. Peter's conduct, religious discrimination and ethnic racism, was not in line with the truth of the gospel. **For the Christian, it's not that God's Law, but rather that racism is not in line with God's Gospel.** "The process of renewing every dimension of our life - spiritual, psychological, cognitive, thinking, hoping and living out the "lines" or ramifications of the gospel."
